<b>Retirement Benefits</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Instead of social security tax being taken out of each paycheck, UF residents are automatically enrolled in the FICA alternative plan, where you place that same money in an investment account and choose how to allocate the funds to maximize your return for retirement</li> </ul>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Amount you will have saved in 3 years (assuming 6% return)</li> </ul>	\$13732
